One thing that has not changed is our dedication to those with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families.

#### Why did The Arc of Laramie County change its mission statement?

The Arc of Laramie County has recently changed its programming and updated its mission statement to reflect what The Arc hopes to continue to achieve. The Arc of Laramie County is committed to expanding opportunities for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities so they can be included in their community. The Arc promotes access to quality support services to assist families, provides training, and builds a local network of advocates.

#### What programming does The Arc of Laramie County

The Arc offers a variety of programming to meet the needs of individual with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Our supportive services include assistance with employment applications, resume writing, and application assistance for programs such as food stamps, SSI and housing. We still offer activities such as bowling, other monthly social activities, and an art class to help promote inclusion and social networking. The Arc provides bus passes and punch cards through a short application process. We also provide educational classes such as our social skills group, which promotes healthy relationships, healthy lifestyles and independence. We also offer education classes that help bring awareness about different disabilities to our community in general. In promoting these activities, we want you to know that many of these programs cost money, but our goal is minimize the cost for our clients and their families. To accomplish this, we have to promote "actual" productive fund raising events.

#### What happened to the Governor's Christmas Tree Lighting?

Due to the construction at the Capitol the last few years we have had to put this event on hold. Our search to find an alternate location that is large enough for all in the state to participate was not successful. We hope that construction will be done in July of 2019 and that the Governor's Tree lighting will return in December of 2019.

#### Who can join The Arc and What ages do you serve?

Arc memberships are open to those with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families. We also encourage community members

#### What happened to The Dance in the Buff Fundraiser?

Fundraisers are essential for The Arc of Laramie County's future success. In deciding on which fundraisers we are going to host, we must consider many aspects including the following: the cost to host the fundraisers (venue, food, auction items, etc.), the target audience that will be the best potential donors, how much money will be potentially earned from that event, how many times can we ask a local business for a donation to support a reasonable number of fund raisers in our own community, how many fundraisers can we actually have and not overwhelm our donor base, and the thus the total cost of our Arc Fundraiser being held. The purpose of our fund raising is so that The Arc may continue to expand our programming and for us to help as many individuals as possible. In considering all these inherent factors, some fundraisers such as "Dance in the Buff", have proven that it doesn't make enough profit for us to host it in the form that it has been in the past. Fund raising events have to be to some extent, a separate activity than a social event. Fund raising is a time consuming task and takes months of planning as well. The Arc is always looking for different ideas and/or volunteers to help with fundraisers to make them successful.

#### Why was there no Arc-Scursion in 2018?

There was no Arc-Excursion in 2018 due to the fact that it was cost prohibitive. We try to keep the trip cost around \$20.00 per person. However, as prices have continued to rise, so does the cost of the bus rental and the cost of the activity itself. We welcome your suggestions on places you would like to visit and if any of the families have contacts with individuals, that may assist us with affordable transportation and/or activities, please share that information with us. We will continue to seek out cost effective activities for our clients to give them a variety of activities that they can look forward to each year.

#### How can I continue to help The Arc of Laramie

The Arc of Laramie County receives no funding from any government entity. We rely solely on donations, sponsorships, fundraisers, grants that we are eligible for, and membership dues to provide programming.
